How it works

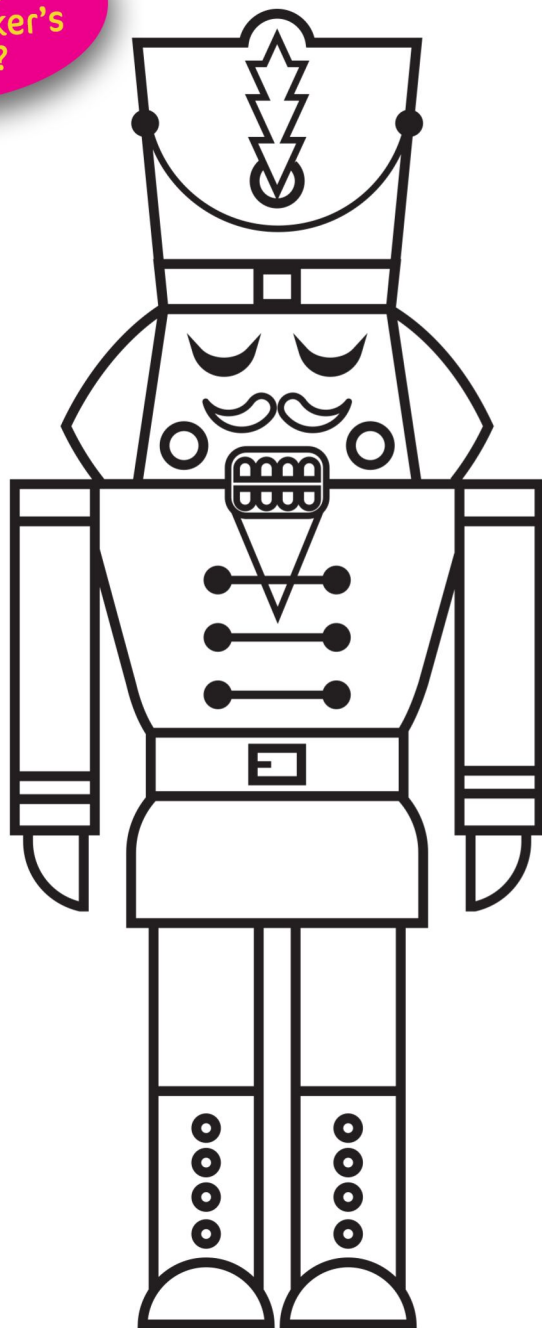
